TERM 2

- FSK10113 Cert I Skills for Vocational Pathways and FSK20113 Cert II Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways
- Engineering Part Oval

TERM 3

- Electrotechnology Part Qual or Certificate II in Automotive Servicing Technology - option to enrol in either one based on preferences and is dependent on student demand
- Work Placement
